

Accused is present.

The accused voluntarily submits to plead guilty of the offence against him. The court has warned the accused that if he pleads guilty, he may have to pay fine. In spite of the same, the accused proceeded to plead guilty. The gist of accusation for the offence punishable under section 281 and 125(a),125(b) of BNS and 134 of IMV Act., is recorded in the form of plea. The same is read over and explained to the accused in the kannada language known to him. he understood the same and he pleaded guilty of the offence alleged against him. The plea of guilty by the accused is found voluntarily. Hence, the Court proceeds to pass following ..

ORDER

Acting under section 275 of B.N.S.S 2023 accused is convicted for the offence punishable under section 281 and 125(a),125(b) of BNS and 134 of IMV Act.

Since the accused has pleaded guilty before Lok Adalath and has this a first time offence, lenient view is taken and accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- For the offence punishable under section 281 of BNS. In default of

payment of fine, they shall undergo S.I. for 05 days.

Further the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.2,500/- for the offence punishable under section 125(a) of BNS. In default of payment of fine, he shall undergo S.I. for 05 days.

Further the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 1,000/- for the offence punishable under section 125(b) of BNS. In default of payment of fine, he shall undergo S.I. for 05 days.

Further the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1000/- for the offence punishable under section 134 of IMV Act. In default of payment of fine, he shall undergo S.I. for 05 days.

The accused is permitted to pay fine on or before 11.07.2026
