ORDER

Case advance today. Sri. MYN Advocate filed vakalath to the Respondent No. 1 and 2. Both parties and their counsel present. The petitioner filed IA No. 6 Rule 17 of CPC. Other side submit no objection. Same allowed. Both parties have filed compromise petition Under Order 23 Rule 3 of CPC along with sketch. Accordingly the parties have got divided the respective share and Respondent No. 3 has received amount for Rs. 33,82,000/- through DD No. 828511 dated 13-08-2026. Contents of compromise petition are read over and explained to the parties. They submit that they have signed compromise petition having understood its contents, terms and conditions without any coercion, threat or undue influence, misrepresentation etc. Perused the case records, by enquiry, it appears that the parties have voluntarily entered into the compromise and the compromise is in accordance with law. The compromise petition is satisfied and same accepted. The compromise petition shall form part and parcel of decree. Office is directed to draw final decree accordingly. The sketch furnish by the parties with compromise petition is part and parcel of the decree.
