

A-1 and 2 are present. Sri MGR advocate files vakalath for them. Accused pray time to compound the offences. Call again. Again matter is taken up at 1.45 p.m. Sri NTS advocate files memo stating that already accused have compounded the offences with the competent authority by paying penalty of Rs.35,400/-. Copy of the Govt. challan is also produced. Since offences alleged are compoundable, as provided U/S.23A(2) of the Act r/w/s 320(8) of Cr.P.C. accused are acquitted. Interim custody of vehicle is made absolute. Sample material collected if any, being valueless, it is ordered to be destroyed.
