Today is fixed for exparte injunction hearing.

Plaintiffs file hazira.

Perused injunction petition and materials on record. Heard submission for plaintiffs.

Contention for plaintiffs is that defendant no. 1 is the son of plaintiff no. 1 and he is trying to capture more than his share by constructing building though suit property is not partitioned between the co-sharers.

Considering the materials available on record as well as pleading, it appears that plaintiffs have prima facie case and balance of convenience and inconvenience in their favour. It also appears that plaintiffs will suffer from irreparable loss and injury if injunction is not granted. But finding both the parties having share in suit property as admitted and suit is for partition, this Court is inclined to allow the prayer made to the tune of status quo.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that petition for temporary injunction U/O 39 Rule 1 & 2 C.P.C. is allowed exparte and disposed of.

Both the plaintiffs and defendant no. 1 are directed to maintain status quo in respect of nature, character and possession of the suit property till disposal of suit.
