1 *Heard the learned advocate for the plaintiff.*

2 *The plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendant and summons has been duly served to the defendant. Thereafter, the defendant has not appeared before the court and has not filed his appearance. Therefore, the plaintiff has given the application to pass exparte decree against the defendant vide exhibit – 7 with affidavit. Therefore, when the defendant has not filed his appearance after duly serving the summons, Therefore, under Order 37 Rule 2(3) the plaintiff is entitled to get the exparte decree against the defendant. Therefore, I pass the following final order.*

O R D E R

1 *Decree of Rs.2,15,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifteen Thousand Only) is passed against the defendant with cost of the suit and interest on Rs.2,15,000/- at the rate of 6% per annum from the date of the suit till realisation.*

2 *Decree to be drawn accordingly.*
