

**Vijay Kumar Versus State of Punjab**

**ORDER**

Bail application has been received from Id.Vacation Judge, Sangrur. It be registered.

1. This order of mine shall dispose of first bail application under Section 483 BNSS filed by applicant-accused Vijay Kumar @ Bhola, for his release on regular bail in FIR No.106 dated 30.05.2026, under Sections 21 & 29 of ND&PS Act, P.S. Dirba.

2. Ld.Counsel for applicant has submitted that applicant has been falsely implicated. He is in custody since 30.05.2026. Nothing is to be recovered from him. Otherwise also, the recovery effected from the accused is non-commercial. Completion of investigation and conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time. He has prayed for the acceptance of bail application.

3. Upon notice, Id. Addl. Public Prosecutor for State assisted by SI Navjot Singh has opposed the bail application alleging that recovery of 07 grams heroin had been effected from accused and they have prayed for the dismissal of bail application. Police record produced which was seen and returned.

4. I have heard and considered the submissions of both the sides and gone through the record.

5. The perusal of record shows that applicant/accused Vijay Kumar @ Bhola was arrested in this case on 30.05.2026 as he was found in conscious possession of 07 grams of heroin and since then, he was in custody. In the case in hand, the recovery effected from accused is non commercial in nature. Completion of investigation and conclusion of trial would take sufficient long time. No purpose would be served by keeping the accused/applicant in custody anymore who is already in custody since 30.05.2026. So, applicant/accused is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of Id.Area/Duty Magistrate. Applicant be also intimated immediately about the order granting bail through Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur through e-mail. Copy of this order be sent to Id. Area Magistrate for compliance. Record of this bail application be tagged with the connected papers.
