This case is referred by Senior Civil Judge and JMFC., Hiriya, before **Additional Civil Judge & JMFC, Hiriya** as per Notification for Constitutes of bench for conciliation before Lok-Adalath.

The Petitioner No.1 and 2 and L/C for the petitioners present. Sri.B.K advocate present on behalf of Respondent No.2. Both parties have filed joint memo.

The matter was settled between the Petitioners and Respondent No.2 for a sum of **Rs. 14,00,000/-**.

The contents of the joint memo read over. The petitioner agreed and admitted the same. It appears that there is no coercion and undue influence and compromise is entered

between the parties on their own will.
Hence there is no impediment to allow
the joint memo. Accordingly proceed
to pass following:

ORDER

Joint memo filed by the petitioner
No.1 and 2 and Respondent No.2 is
hereby accepted.

The Respondent No.2 is hereby
directed to deposit the compromise
amount of **Rs. 14,00,000/-** within one
month from the date of this order.

The petitioner No.1 and 2 are
entitled to receive award amount in the
ratio of 70:30 respectively.

After the amount is deposited,
office is hereby directed to release the
70% awarded amount of the petitioner
No.1 shall be released and remaining
30% shall be kept in F.D in favour of
petitioner No.1 in any nationalized
bank for a period of 3 years.

The entire share amount of the
petitioner No. 2 shall be released
through K.2 process on proper
identification.

Draw Award accordingly.
