

ORDERS ON IA No.1

After hearing the learned counsel for the plaintiff and on perusal of the records prima facie it appears that, the plaintiffs and defendants are relatives to each other. The plaintiff is claimed 1/8th share in suit A schedule properties. These properties are standing in the names of defendant No. 1, 6, 8 to 10 in public records. The apprehension of the plaintiffs that, defendants taking advantage of entry of their names in the revenue records, they may alienate the suit schedule properties to the strangers appears to be genuine.

At this stage, the plaintiff has made out prima facie case for grant of exparte temporary injunction order, other wise the very purpose of filing of IA.1 will be defeated. The merits of application have to be considered when the defendant No. 1, 6, 8 to

10 took their appearance. Hence, to avoid multiplicity of the proceedings and for the ends of justice, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Pending disposal of IA.No.1 filed by plaintiffs U/O. XXXIX R. 1 & 2 of CPC the defendant No.1, 6, 8 to 10 and all persons claiming through them is hereby restrained by order of ad-interim injunction from alienating the suit schedule (A) properties in any manner, in favour of anybody till their appearance.

The plaintiff shall comply with provisions of order 39 rule 3(a) of CPC.

Office to issue T.I order only after compliance is made and process fee with copies of pleadings are furnished.

Issue suit summons to the defendant No.1 to 10 and notice of I.A.1 and TI order. To defendant No. 1, 6, 8 to 10 R/by 27.05.2024.
