The plaintiff has filed I.A.No.11 U/o.6 R. 17 of CPC to amend the body of the plaint so as to explain the facts regarding the registered will dt.14.11.2014 and corresponding amendment in prayer column to add additional prayer to declare said will as null and void and not binding on the rights of the plaintiff.

The instant suit is filed for partition and separate possession considering the nature of the suit I am of the opinion that, proposed amendment is just and proper to adjudicate the controversy between the parties effectively. Hence the following:

Order

The I.A.No.11 filed by the plaintiff U/o.6 R. 17 of CPC is allowed on cost of Rs.500/-. Thereby plaintiff is

permitted to carryout necessary
amendment within 7days from this
