

ORDERS ON IA No.7 FILED BY THE
GUARDIAN OF PLAINTIFF No.2
U/O.XXXII R.12 R/W Sec.151 OF CPC

The Guardian of plaintiff No.2 has filed this application U/O.XXXII R.12 r/w Sec.151 of CPC and prays this Court to discharge her from the guardianship of plaintiff No.2 as he has attained majority and permit him to proceed with the matter independently.

The plaintiff No.2 has filed his sworn affidavit in support of this application.

I have heard Smt. CAU Advocate on this application.

The plaintiffs have filed this suit against the defendants seeking the relief of partition and separate possession of their 1/9th share in the suit schedule properties by metes and bounds. At the time of filing of this suit, the plaintiff No.2 was minor and hence, his natural guardian, the mother has filed the suit.

Now the plaintiff No.2 has furnished the notarized copies of his SSLC marks card and Aadhar card to substantiate the fact that he has attained majority. As per these documents, the plaintiff No.2 was

born on 28.11.1996. As on the date of filing of this application, the plaintiff No.2 has attained majority. Therefore, he is entitled to proceed with the case independently .

As the plaintiff No.2 has attained majority, it is just and proper to discharge Smt. Veenakshi K.L from his guardianship and permit the plaintiff No.2 to proceed with the case independently. By considering all these aspects, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

I.A.No.7 filed by the guardian of the plaintiff No.2 U/O. XXXII R.12 r/w Sec.151 of CPC is hereby allowed.

Smt. Veenakshi K.L is discharged from the guardianship of plaintiff No.2. The plaintiff No.2 is permitted to proceed with the case independently, as he has attained majority.

The plaintiffs are hereby directed to make necessary amendment in the cause title of

the plaintiff regarding the discharge of the guardianship of plaintiff No.2 and file amended plaintiff.
