The Jdr's filed I.A.No.IV u/sec.151 of CPC and prayed to permit him to file his objections.

Per contra, the DHr filed objections and prayed to reject the application for the reasons mentioned in the objection.

5. The point that arises for consideration is as follows:-

1. "Whether the J.Drs made out sufficient grounds to file the objection as prayed in the I.A.No.II "

REASONS

5. Point No.1: In support of the application, the learned counsel for the JDr filed memorandum of facts and stated that he had recently obtained a certified copy from the Central Record Room, hence, the delay was caused.

It is the contention of the DHr that the JDr filed the present application after a lapse of 5 years with an intention to drag on the proceedings.

6. In the objections, the JDr contended that the DHr had not correctly calculated the principal amount and calculated interest on the entire principal amount, which is not proper. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice, this court is of the opinion that it is a fit case to condone the delay in filing objections. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

The I. A. No. IV filed by the JDr's
U/sec. 151 of CPC is hereby allowed
with cost of Rs.500/-.
