

**ORDERS**

After hearing for learned counsel for plaintiff and perused the records it appears that, the suit properties on the strength of MR No.H.42 . The suit property has been mutated in the name of defendant No.3. Further it appears that, the defendant No.3 taking advantage of entry of his name for suit property may alienate the same to strangers.

At this stage the plaintiff has made of prima facie case for grant of exparte T.I order, if the notice of I.A.1 is issued to defendant No.3 then, the very purpose of filing of suit would be defeated. As such it is just a necessary to dispense with service of notice to defendant No.3 the merits of application have to be considered when the defendant No.3 appeared. For the ends of

justice I proceed to pass the following:

**ORDER**

Pending disposal of I.A.No.1 filed by plaintiff U/o.39 R.1 and 2 of CPC the defendant No.3 and all persons claiming to through him is hereby restrained by order of Ad-interim injunction from alienating the suit property in any manner in favour of anybody till his appearance.

The plaintiff shall comply with provisions of O.39 R.3(A) of CPC. Office to issue T.I order only after compliance is made.

Issue summons to defendant No.1 to 4 with notice of I.A.1 and T.I order to defendant No.3. R/by 31.10.2022.
