

On an application filed by Sri. B.L.S Advocate, case is advanced to today.

He filed vakalath for the accused along with bail application U/Sec.436 of Cr.P.C and an application U/Sec.70(2) of Cr.P.C.

Accused present.

Heard Sri. B.L.S Advocate on this bail application.

The complainant has filed private complaint against the accused for the offence punishable U/Sec.138 of N.I Act. This court had issued summons to the accused. In response to the service of summons, he filed application U/Sec.205 of Cr.P.C through his counsel and sought for dispensation of his appearance for the day. Accordingly, this court allowed the application.

On the subsequent date of hearing, the accused did not appear before the Court. Hence, this court issued NBW against him to secure his presence.

Today the accused voluntarily appeared before the court. The alleged offence is bailable and it is triable by this court. The alleged offence is not punishable with death or life imprisonment.

The custodial interrogation of the accused is not required in this case. The accused is ready to abide by all the conditions, which would be imposed on him by this court.

By considering all these aspects, the bail application filed by the accused U/Sec.436 of Cr.P.C is hereby allowed on the following conditions.

1. He shall execute a self bond for Rs.1,50,000/- with one surety .
2. He shall not threaten the complainant and his witnesses.
