

Orders On I.A No.6

The plaintiff filed I. A No.6 U/o. 1 rule 10(2) of CPC and prays to permit him to implead the proposed defendants as defendant No.3 and 4.

Perused the record. After service of notice the proposed defendants appeared through their counsel and not filed any objections.

It is the contention of the plaintiff that the legal heirs of defendant No.2 who are defendant No.2(a to e) are executed registered sale deed pertaining to the suit schedule properties in favour of the proposed defendant No.3 and 4 on 15.10.2025, hence they are necessary parties to the suit.

The plaintiff filed suit against the defendants for partition and separate possession. At this stage there is no reasons to disbelieve the contention of the plaintiff.

Hence the presence of proposed defendants are just and necessary to decide the controversy between the

parties. Accordingly proceed to pass the following-

ORDER

I.A No.6 filed by the plaintiff U/o.1 rule 10(2) of CPC is hereby allowed.

The plaintiff is permitted to implead the proposed defendants as defendant No.3 and 4 . For amendment.
