Reply on behalf of IO filed. Copy supplied. Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is submitted that complainant has refused to participate in the TIP proceedings. It is submitted that grand father of the applicant expired on 13.12.2025 and therefore, applicant may be granted bail.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State submits that applicant was arrested by Special Staff, District North, Maurice Nagar and from his possession stolen mobile phone, which is the case property of the present case was recovered. The allegations are serious in nature, hence bail application may be dismissed.

I have heard Ld. Counsels for the parties and perused the record.

In the present case, as per the reply on 28.04.2025 complaint was made with respect to snatching of the mobile phone by two unknown persons. accused/applicant was arrested by Special Staff on 24.09.2025 and from his possession mobile phone of the present case was recovered. Intimation was sent in the police station Wazirabad and accordingly, the present applicant was formally arrested on 06.12.2025. IO has orally submitted that

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complainant did not join the TIP proceedings. Hence, at this stage, the only allegations against the present applicant is in respect of recovery of stolen mobile phone. Intimation to the police station was given on 24.09.2025, IO arrested the present applicant after the expiry of two months.

Considering the overall facts and circumstances, the applicant is admitted to bail on furnishing P/B and S/B of Rs. 15,000/-with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Ld. JMFC/Ld. Duty JMFC/Ld. Link JMFC and also subject to the following conditions:

- a) *The applicant/accused shall under no circumstances leave the country;*
- b) *The applicant/accused shall inform the Court in the event of change of his address, within two weeks.*
- c) *The applicant/accused shall not commit any offence in the event of there being any FIR/DD Entry/ Complaint lodged against the applicant, it would be open to the State to seek cancellation of the application which application, if any, filed would be considered on its own merits.*

The concerned Ahlmad is directed to bring to the notice of the Court, if the applicant/accused fails to furnish the bail bonds within 30 days from today, for conducting a review in terms of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of *"In Re Policy Strategy For Grant of Bail"* SMWP (Criminal) No. 04/2021 dated 31.01.2023, wherein the guidelines are laid down in this regard.

Application stands disposed off.
