State Vs. Aslam Khan etc.

QUANTUM OF SENTENCE:

Present: Shri Navdeep Goyal, Additional Public Prosecutor for State assisted by Shri N.S. Dhaliwal, Advocate for complainant. Convicts Aslam Khan and accused Prince Khan in custody with Shri Sirjiwan Jain, Advocate.

1. I have heard the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State as well as convicts on the question of sentence.

2. Convict Aslam Khan alias Aslam Mohammad alias Aasa pleaded that he is a poor person and the only breadwinner of the family and that he has a son aged about 09 years and he is the sole custodian of his son, who is now being looked after by his 80 years old father and prayed that lenient view be taken.

3. Convict Prince Khan alias Prince Mohammad pleaded that he is a poor person and the only breadwinner of his family and his parents are old aged persons and prayed that lenient view be taken.

4. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor has argued that the convicts are not entitled to get any relief or leniency, as they have committed a heinous offence and thus they may be punished with maximum punishment and fine so that a deterrent message be sent to the society and like-minded persons be discouraged from entering into criminal activity.

5. I have considered the arguments advanced by both sides and carefully examined the record.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the request of the convicts for a lenient sentence. However, after carefully considering all the facts and circumstances of the case, including the mitigating factors raised by the defence, the convicts are sentenced as under:

Convict Aslam Khan alias Aasa alias Aslam Mohammad

Under Section	Imprisonment awarded	Fine	Punishment In default of payment of fine
302 IPC	To undergo Rigorous imprisonment for Life.	Rs.10,000/-	To undergo Rigorous imprisonment for a period of 01 year.

Convict Prince Khan alias Prince Mohammad

Under Section	Imprisonment awarded	Fine	Punishment In default of payment of fine
302/34 IPC	To undergo Rigorous imprisonment for Life.	Rs.10,000/-	To undergo Rigorous imprisonment for a period of 01 year.

4. The period of detention, if any, already undergone by the convicts in this case during investigation or trial, shall be set off against the substantive sentence awarded to them. Case property be disposed off, as per rules, after the expiry of the period of appeal/revision, if any preferred. Copy of the judgment and order of sentence be given to the convicts free of costs. Fine not paid. Jail warrants be prepared. File be consigned to the record room.

Case property be disposed off, as per rules, after the expiry of the period of appeal/revision, if any preferred. Copy of the judgment and order of sentence be given to the convicts free of costs. Fine not paid. Jail warrants be prepared. File be consigned to the record room.
