ORDER ON BIRTHS AND DEATHS REGISTRATION ACT

The petitioner has filed this petition U/S.13(3) of Birth and Death Registration Act seeking to direct the respondent for registering his son's date of birth in the concerned register.

02. It is alleged in the petition that, the date of birth of petitioner's son has not been entered in the Birth and Death Register of the Respondent, due to lack of knowledge.

03. In spite of service of notice, the respondent remained absent before the court and hence placed ex parte.

04. Petitioner examined himself as PW.1 and got marked documents from Ex.P.1 to 5. Respondent not let in evidence.

05. Heard arguments, perused the materials on record.

06. Petitioner examined himself as P.W.1 and has produced the documents at Ex.P.1 to Ex.P.5. Ex.P.1 is the endorsement issued by The Commissioner, BBMP, Bangalore. *Ex.P.2 is the notarized copy SSLC marks card of the petitioner's son and Ex.P.3 to 5 are the notarized copies of Aadhar cards of petitioner, his son and wife.* All these documents reveals that date of birth of the petitioner's son is **12.08.2004**. Ex.P.1 is the endorsement issued by the respondent which reveals that, the date of birth of petitioner's son has not entered in the concerned register.

07. In spite of service of notice, respondent remained absent. Hence, the pleadings and evidence placed by the petitioner remained unchallenged. The documents are in consonance with the pleadings and evidence of the petitioner. There is nothing on record to disbelieve the case of petitioner. The registration date of birth of the petitioner's son is required for

further correspondence. Hence, herequires the birth certificate. Hence, the petition is entitled to be allowed. Accordingly, the following;

ORDER

Petition is allowed.

Respondent is directed to cause entry in the concerned register, the date of birth of the petitioner's son by name **RAVIPRAKASH S TAHASHEELDAR, S/o SHIVAJI D TAHASHEELDAR and SMT. INDIRA**, who was born on **12.08.2004**, at No.211, 12th Main Road, 3rd Cross, Manjunathanagar, Rajajinagar, Bengaluru – 560 010.

Issue direction to the respondent to issue **Birth Certificate** accordingly, after collecting necessary late fee from the petitioner.
