3. Whether the plaintiffs further prove that the alleged registered partition dated 16.11.2006 , had been taken place in a fraudulent manner which do not bind the rights of plaintiffs on their share in the suit schedule properties?
4. Whether defendant No.2 to 5 prove that the defendant No.2 had sold suit schedule Item No.5 property in favour of Defendant No.6 to clear off family debts upon oral consent of all the defendants ?
5. Whether D-1, 3 and 4 prove that the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties?
6. Whether D-1, 3 and 4 prove that the suit is bad for non-inclusion of properties?
7. Whether suit is barred by limitation ?
8. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to the relief as sought for?
9. What order or decree?
