Sri.HR advocate for the above accused persons has filed vakalath on behalf of accused persons and also application U/sec. 437 of Cr.Pc. Prays for the enlargement of accused persons on bail for the alleged offence punishable U/sec.323, 324, 354, 504, 506 R/w 34 of IPC.

Copies U/Sec.207 of CRPC duly supplied to the accused persons.

Learned APP filed objection .

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the accused persons and also the learned APP appearing for the state.

After going through the case papers, it appears from the record the present accused persons have been ordered to be enlarged on bail U/Sec.438 of Cr.P.C by the order of Hon'ble Court of Prl. District and Sessions Judge in Crl.Misc. No.663/2023 dated 31-05-2023 For the offences punishable U/sec.323, 324, 354, 504, 506 R/w 34 of IPC.

ORDER

The B/A filed U/Sec.437 of CRPC by the accused persons is allowed, subject to the following conditions.

1. The accused persons shall execute personal bond of Rs.50,000/- each with like sum surety.

2. The accused persons shall not

tamper the prosecution witness in any manner.

3. The accused persons shall not involve in similar offence.

4. The accused persons shall appear before the Court regular adjourned date and also directed to comply with the conditions imposed by the Honble Prl. District and Sessions Court, Chitradurga.

Furnished surety by name Sri.Basappa S/o late Rangappa, Aged about 68 years, agriculturist, R/o Talikatte village, Ramagiri Hobli, Holalkre Taluk, Produced RTC bearing R.Sy.55/4 measuring 1 acre, situated at R.D Kavalu village, Holalkere Taluk, for security purpose and produced xerox Aadhar card for his identification and also filed surety declaration U/Sec.441A of CRPC.

Examined and Surety is satisfied and accepted. The accused persons also produced self attested copies of Adhar cards in respect of their address proof. Office is hereby directed to take the bonds of accused persons and their Surety.
