1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the suit schedule properties are ancestral joint family properties and enjoying jointly by the plaintiffs and defendants?
2. Whether plaintiffs further prove that during the lifetime of Sanneerappa S/o Avalappa Pujari and father of the defendant No.1 and 2 in the 1973 got partition some joint family properties as per registered partition deed dated 12.04.1973 for sake of availing some loans from banks and it is nominal one?
3. Whether plaintiffs further prove that the nominal registered partition deed dated 12.04.1973 is not binding upon their rights and shares over the suit schedule properties?
4. Whether defendant No.1 proves that in the year 1973 partition was effected and allotted the share to the father of the plaintiffs and it is acted upon?
5. Whether plaintiffs are entitled partition and separate possession of their half share over the suit schedule properties?
6. What order or decree ?
