Both parties and counsel appeared before court.

As per joint memo filed by the Counsel for the plaintiffs and defendants. Both counsels are present. Both parties are present before the court.

Both parties have filed joint memo stating that, they have compromised the dispute in its entirety/fully. The petition is duly signed by both parties and their respective Advocates.

The contents of the compromise petition have been read over to the parties in Kannada Language which is their mother tongue.

They have understood the contents of the same. This Court is of the opinion that, the parties have compromised the matter out of their own volition.

There are no factual and legal inhibitions to accept the compromise. Accordingly, following order is passed:

ORDER

joint memo is accepted. Suit is decreed in terms of compromise petition.

The compromise petition shall be part and parcel of the decree.

Draw decree as per terms and conditions of the compromise petition

Both parties are directed to produce the identity Card/Adhaar Card without fail.
