ORDER:

1. Heard on the bail application moved by applicant **Kuldeep Singh**, under Section 483 BNSS. Upon notice, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State appeared and opposed it.
2. As has transpired from the record, on 30.05.2026 accused/bail applicant along with co-accused were apprehended by the police party. From the boot space of the car owned by co-accused Kulwinder Singh, 25 Kilograms of poppy husk was recovered. The quantity of the contraband so recovered from his possession falls in the category of less than commercial quantity. As such, stringent provisions of 37 of ibid Act are not attracted to the present case. Bail applicant/accused is in judicial custody since 30.05.2026. His custodial interrogation has already been completed. Nothing further is to be recovered from the accused/applicant. Presentation of challan and completion of trial is likely to take time. Keeping in view the recovery and date of arrest of applicant/accused, the bail application is **allowed** and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate with the

condition that applicant/accused will neither leave the country without prior permission of the Court, nor he will tamper with the witnesses of the prosecution and he will appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing. Police record be returned. Copy of order be sent immediately to the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate for compliance.

3. File be tagged with the remand papers.
