01.07.2026	1. All these three anticipatory bail petitions are related to the same P.S. case, i.e., Ara Muffasil P.S. Case FIR No. 168 of 2026, hence, all these three anticipatory bail petitions are decided by this Common Order. 2. A.B.P No. 1550 of 2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner, namely, Sanjay Ray, A.B.P No. 1558 of 2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, 1. Basant Ray 2. Ajay Ray 3. Rajnarayan Ray and A.B.P No. 1828 of 2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner, namely, Guddu Kumar, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Ara Muffasil P.S. Case FIR No. 168/2026 u/ss. 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 74, 109, 352 and 351(2) of B.N.S., put up for hearing. 3. Heard Shri Manoj Kumar, Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners as well as Shri Rana Pratap Singh Learned P.P. for the State. Shri Surendra Prasad Singh, Ld. Counsel for the Informant. 4. On the written complaint of Rajesh Prasad this FIR was lodged against 24 accused persons along with 30-35 unknown persons and it is the case of prosecution that on 19.05.2026 at about 07:00 A.M. when accused persons, namely, Chandan Rai, Babloo Kumar and Arun Kumar informed to informant that a meeting was conducted near Kali Temple of his village at about 08:00 P.M. and when informant reached there then all FIR named accused persons along with unknown persons suddenly attacked with	
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Contd. 01.07.2026	lathi, danda & iron rod and mercilessly beaten informant. During fight accused Chandan Rai hit on the eye of informant with danda and accused Babloo Kumar attacked with iron rod on head of the informant's son and due to which informant's son received head injury. Thereafter all accused persons entered into the house of informant and started misbehaving with family of the informant and when informant's son called to police then all accused persons ran away, hence, this FIR was lodged. 5. Learned Counsel for the Petitioners submitted that no bail petition of any nature has been filed or is pending on behalf of the petitioners either before this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court to the present one and petitioners are men of clean antecedent as per para 22 of the case diary. It is also submitted that petitioners are innocent, have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners also submitted that there is no specific allegation of any overt act or covert act made against any of the petitioners herein. The allegations against the petitioners herein are general, omnibus, exaggerated, bald and

Counsel for the Petitioners further submitted that informant and petitioners are co-villagers/next door neighbour/'Gotiya' to each other and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioners are men of clean antecedents, permanent resident of Bhojpur, and they undertake to comply with any conditions imposed by this Court, hence, anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners may be allowed. 6. On the contrary, Ld. Counsel for the Informant and Learned P.P. vehemently opposed the anticipatory bail petitions of petitioners and submitted that all accused persons in pre-planned manner attacked on informant and caused injury and accused persons entered into the house of informant and they misbehaved with family members of informant, hence, anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners are devoid of merit and same should be dismissed. 7. I have heard the rival arguments of Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners as well as Ld. Counsel for the Informant along with Ld. P.P and perused the case record minutely. In this case total 24 FIR named accused persons and 30 - 35

In the course of investigation, injury report was received and as per injury report of injured Ram Nivas Bin injuries found to be simple in nature and on the other hand injury report of injured/informant/Rajesh Prasad and Jawahir Bin was received and as per injury report of both persons have no injuries found on the body so that injury report cannot be provided, even there is no injury report on record to corroborate the allegations of petitioners with the alleged offence. From perusal of record it shows that there is no specific allegation made against any of the petitioners. It is undisputed fact that general, omnibus, bald, exaggerated and unsubstantiated allegation made against these petitioners and informant and all accused persons are co-villagers/next door neighbour/'Gotiya' to each other. Considering the fact that there is no variable material on record that could connect accused person with the alleged offence. Petitioners are men of clean antecedents, permanent resident of Bhojpur and they undertake to comply with any conditions as imposed by this Court, hence, anticipatory bail

Considering the general and omnibus allegations made against these petitioners and there is no corroborating material available on record to connect the petitioners with the alleged offence, the petitioners are men of clean antecedents and they undertake to comply with any condition as imposed by this court, hence, anticipatory bail petitions of the petitioner, namely, Sanjay Ray in A.B.P No. 1550 of 2026, anticipatory bail petition of petitioners, namely, 1. Basant Ray 2. Ajay Ray 3. Arun Kumar 4. Sunil Kumar Ray @ Sunil Ray 5. Muklesh Ray 6. Hare Ram Kumar 7. Suresh Ray 8. Sipak Ray @ Sipak Kumar 9. Deepak Kumar @ Deepak Ray 10. Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Court below within	
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
