SANJEEV KUMAR Vs SHAINTI

Present: Sh. Satwant Singh Saini Advocate for complainant.
Accused Shainti has been declared Proclaimed Person vide today's order dated 22.07.2026.

Proclamation warrants issued qua accused Shainti under Section 82 Cr.P.C. were received back duly executed on 01.05.2026, for today. Statement of Serving Constable ASI Daljit Kumar No.706/R, posted at Summon Staff, Rupnagar was also recorded regarding due proclamation but accused has not come present. From the aforementioned statement of Executing Constable, this Court is satisfied that proclamation has been duly executed as per provisions contained in Section 82 Cr.P.C. Mandatory period of 30 days has already been lapsed since proclamation dated 01.05.2026 was effected but accused Shainti did not come present on date fixed i.e. 22.07.2026.

As such, accused Shainti is hereby declared as 'Proclaimed Person' in the present case. Intimation be sent to concerned SHO.

Perusal of the file reveals that complainant tendered into evidence his duly sworn affidavit in his preliminary evidence. Hence, this Court deems it fit that the said evidence be read as evidence under Section 299 of Cr.P.C.

List of property of accused Shainti by complainant for the purpose of proceedings under Section 83 Cr.P.C. has not been furnished. This Court does not deem it fit to adjourn the case for the said purpose. Complainant is however at liberty to furnish the list of property, if any in the ownership of accused by filing separate application in this regard.

Since, accused has been declared Proclaimed Person, hence, no useful purpose would be served to keep the present file pending. Hence, file is ordered to be consigned to the record room. File be again put up as and when accused himself surrenders or is apprehended by investigation agency.
