1. Whether the plaintiff proves that the suit schedule properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of the plaintiff and defendants No. 1 to 9 ?
2. Whether the plaintiff proves that the sale deed dated 02.04.2018, executed by defendants No. 1, 7, and 8 in favour of defendant No. 10, pertaining to suit schedule Item No. 1 property, is not binding on the plaintiff's share in the suit schedule property?
3. Whether the plaintiff proves that the registered partition deed dated 18.06.2025, pertaining to suit schedule Item No. 2 property, is null and void and not binding on the rights of the plaintiff over the suit schedule property?
4. Whether the plaintiff proves that the registered gift deed dated 30.06.2025, executed by defendant No. 8 in favour of defendant No. 9, pertaining to suit schedule Item No. 2 property, is not binding on the plaintiff's share in the suit schedule property?
5. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to the relief of permanent injunction as sought in the plaint?

6. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to the relief of partition and separate possession? If so, to what share?
