

ORDER ON IA NO. I

On perusal of the plaint, I.A. No. I along with affidavit and documents produced along with plaint. The plaintiffs have made out a prima-facie case and also balance of convenience lies in favour of plaintiffs to grant an exparte ad-interim injunction. Hence, this court proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

An ex-parte ad-interim injunction is hereby granted.

The defendants or their agents or claiming under them are hereby restrained from interfering or obstructing the religious functions, performing poojas or archanas as per tradition of Sri. Muddulingeshwara Swamy temple, situated in the suit schedule property in any manner, till the next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs shall comply order 39 rule 3 of CPC.

The office is hereby directed to issue T.I. order after compliance.

Office is hereby directed to issue notice on I.A.No. I and suit summons to defendants, if P.F. and copies are furnished.
