

ORDERS ON BAIL PETITION

Sri. C.K.H., Advocate for the accused No.1 to 4 has filed vakalath, surety affidavit and bail application under Section 480 of BNSS for accused No.1 to 4 along with certified copy of order in CrI.Mis.No.1093/2025, dated 26.09.2025 for accused No.1 to 4 granting the bail under Section 482 of BNSS respectively passed by Hon'ble 2nd Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Chitraduraga.

Learned APP received copy.

Perused the certified copies of order in CrI.Mis.No.1093/2025, dated 26.09.2025 for accused No.1 to 4 and heard both the side and I am of the opinion that, the offences alleged against accused No.1 to 4 persons is punishable under Sections 85 and 352 R/w section 3(5) of BNS Act, 2023 and Sec.3 and 4 of DP Act. The alleged offences are non-bailable in nature and they are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. Hence, as the Hon'ble 2nd Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Chitraduraga has already granted anticipatory bail to the accused No.1 to 4. This court is of the opinion that, accused No.1 to 4 are entitled to be enlarged on bail. Hence accused No.1 to 4 are entitled to be enlarged on bail under Section 482 of BNSS. Hence, I pass the following:

ORDER

Application filed by the accused No.1 to 4 U/Sec.480 of BNSS is hereby allowed.

The accused No.1 to 4 is ordered to be granting bail subject to following conditions;

CONDITIONS

- 1) The accused No.1 to 4 shall execute personal bond of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety to the like sum.
- 2) The accused No.1 to 4 shall not tamper prosecution evidence nor threaten the prosecution witnesses.
- 3) The petitioner/accused No.1 to 4 shall not involve in any criminal activity henceforth.
- 4) The accused No.1 to 4 shall co-operate with the investigation officer and shall appear before him as and when directed.
- 5) If accused No.1 to 4 violated any of the conditions as stated above, this bail order shall be cancelled.

For surety.

Surety by name Virupakshi S/o Late Doddaiiah, aged about 58 years, Agriculturist, R/o Ward No.2, Main Road, Tumakurlahalli Village, Molakalmuru Taluk, Chitradurga District, offered him as surety for the release of the accused No.1 to 4. He has also produced attested copy of his Aadhar ID Card along with RTC Extract pertaining to Sy.No.25/3, measuring 1.25 acres, situated at Yarranahalli Village, Molakalmuru Taluk, Chitradurga District worth of Rs.50,00,000/-.
