**CHARGE**

I, **B.Pushpanjali**, B.A., LL.M., 1<sup>st</sup> Addl. Dist. & Sessions Judge,  
Chikkamagaluru, do hereby charge you:

1. Rangaswamy, S/o Krishnappa, Aged 37 years, Agriculturist,
2. Smt. Shwetha @ Annamma, W/o Rangaswamy, Aged 25 years, House wife,
3. Srinivas, S/o Late Venkataramaiah, Aged 42 years, Agriculturist,  
A1 to A3 are R/o H. Rangapura village,  
Tarikere Taluk.
4. D. Venkatesh, S/o Devaiah, Aged 49 years, Coolie, R/o Gantekanive village, Tarikere Taluk.
5. Smt. Mahalakshamma, S/o Krishnappa, Aged 46 years, House wife, R/o H. Rangapura village, Tarikere Taluk.

as follows:

*That on 04.10.2019 at about 2.00 p.m. at H. Rangapura village, Tarikere Taluk, coming within the jurisdiction of Tarikere Police Station, the surveyor and revenue officers had come to measure the land bearing Sy.No.77 belonging to you accused No.1 and the nearby land owner CW1 Sandeep told them not to survey the land as he had filed a suit before the Court and when the officials left the place without surveying and CW1 was proceeding on Bhadra channel road, at that time, you accused No.1 to 5 formed yourselves into an unlawful assembly, with a common object of committing an offence and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 143 of I.P.C., within the cognizance of this Court.*

*Secondly, on the aforesaid date, time and place, you accused persons being the members of unlawful assembly, and in furtherance of the common object of said assembly and in the course of the same transaction, committed an offence of rioting, and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 147 of I.P.C., within the cognizance of this Court.*

*Thirdly, on the aforesaid date, time and place you accused persons being the members of unlawful assembly, and in furtherance of the common object of said assembly and in the course of the same transaction, committed an offence of rioting being armed with deadly weapon like stone and thereby committed*

*an offence punishable under Section 148 of I.P.C., within the cognizance of this Court.*

*Fourthly, on the aforesaid date, time and place, you accused persons being the members of unlawful assembly, and in furtherance of the common object of said assembly and in the course of the same transaction, you accused persons abused CW1 in filthy language and thereby insulted him and provoked him to commit breach of peace and thereby committed the offence punishable under Section 504 r/w Section 149 of I.P.C., within the cognizance of this Court.*

*Fifthly, on the aforesaid date, time and place, you accused persons being the members of unlawful assembly, and in furtherance of the common object of said assembly and in the course of the same transaction, you accused No.2 voluntarily caused hurt to CW1 by assaulting him with hands on his person and thereby committed the offence punishable under section 323 r/w Section 149 of I.P.C., within the cognizance of this Court.*

*Lastly, on the aforesaid date, time and place, you accused persons being the members of unlawful assembly, and in furtherance of the common object of said assembly and in the course of the same transaction, you accused No.1 voluntarily caused hurt to CW1 by assaulting him with a stone on his chest and*

*thereby committed the offence punishable under section 324 r/w  
Section 149 of I.P.C., within the cognizance of this Court.*
