04.05.2024	Today the record has been put up for orders before me filed on behalf of the decree holder. No rejoinder has been filed on behalf of the judgment debtor. Pressing the application, the learned advocate for the decree holder have submitted that the said execution case has been fully satisfied as the total decretal amount has been paid by the judgment debtor, thus, this case be disposed as being fully satisfied and prayed the Court to pass appropriate orders for the end of justice. From perusal of the record, it appears that the said execution case was instituted by the decree holder M/s SBI Cards Payment & Services Pvt. Ltd. against judgment debtor Ezaz/Tauhid for realization of award amounting to Rs.74,601.81/- with interest and cost of the suit. The learned advocate of the decree holder have submitted that the loan amount has been paid and after Court process settlement with the judgment debtor has been made and decree holder does not want to pursue the case as the amount have been realized. Considering the fact that this is a simple matter of loan amount which has already been paid by the judgment debtors, this Court is of the considered view that nothing further survives in this matter. Thus, this Court finds that there is no impediment or obstacle in accepting the petition of the decree holder and the decree stands executed in terms of payment being made by the judgment debtors and the decree being fully satisfied. The execution case stands disposed as being fully satisfied.
