:: ORDER ::

Present application is filed by the applicant under Section

482 of Bharatiya Nagrik Surksha Sanhita, 2023 (in short "BNSS") for seeking bail in the event of arrest of the applicant at the hands of Amboli Police Station vide C.R.No.611 of 2026 for offences punishable under Sections 318(4), 336(2), 336(3), 340(2) r/w Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (in short "BNS").

2. The brief facts of the prosecution case are as under:-

The First Information Report has been lodged by the informant API stating that, the informant was conducting investigation in the offence bearing CR No.136/2026 registered with Shirgaon Police Station, Pune. While conducting investigation in the said offence, it was revealed that the accused therein moved application for return of this Audi Car bearing No.MH-04-HN-5254 at Magistrate Court, at Vadgaon, Mawal. In the said application, the accused therein mentioned his original address to be at South Delhi and current address to be at Andheri(West), Mumbai. His Aadhar Card was also annexed with the said application bearing Aadhar Card No.8077 4362 9590, specifying his address at Delhi. When the informant was investigating about the documents of the said seized vehicle with RTO, Andheri(W), it was noticed that the said accused had submitted his Aadhar Card bearing No.4757 8898 9592 of address Andheri(W). During further inquiry it was revealed that from 12.03.2026 till 06.05.2026, the said accused in furtherance of his common intention with other accused, prepared bogus Aadhar card, and having knowledge that, used it as genuine, submitted it with RTO, Andheri(W) and got transferred the same at the address of the said accused at Andheri(W). Therefore, First Information Report was initially lodged with Shirgaon Police Station with FIR No.00/2026 for the offences punishable under Section 318(4), 336(2), 336(3), 340(2) read with Section 3(5) of the BNS, and it was

subsequently transferred to Amboli Police Station having territorial jurisdiction. After such transfer, the said offence came to be numbered as CR No.611/2026 for the offences punishable under Section 318(4), 336(2), 336(3), 340(2) read with Section 3(5) of the BNS.

3. Ld. Advocate for the applicant while advancing arguments submitted that, the applicant never attempted to evade investigation. No notice under Section 35(3) of the BNSS has been served on him either by Shirgaon Police Station or Amboli Police Station. The applicant is ready and willing to appear before the Investigating Officer. The allegations against the applicant are false and baseless. He has been implicated merely on account of his professional association with the selling of the cars, he has nothing to do with the documentation process of transfer of vehicles. The prosecution has failed to disclose any material demonstrating criminal intention and criminal motive coupled with active participation of the applicant with the present offence. The custodial interrogation of the applicant is not required. He is falsely implicated in the offence. He is permanent resident of Mumbai. He has no criminal antecedents. He is ready to abide by all the conditions that may be imposed by this court. Hence the application.

4. The application has been resisted by the prosecution by filing reply at Exh.3 contending that, after registration of First Information Report, the investigation has commenced. The investigation is at primary level. The investigation with respect to forged documents is required to be made. If the application is considered at this stage, there is every possibility of tampering prosecution evidence and absconding of the applicant. Therefore prosecution has prayed for

rejection of the present application.

5. I have heard both the sides. I have gone through the case diary. The case diary goes to show that the investigation is just commenced and it is at primary level. The present offence was initially registered with Shirgaon Police Station, thereafter transferred to Amboli Police Station. On the bare perusal of the First Information Report, it is seen that the API of Anti-Narcotic Squad has set the criminal law in motion, when he was investigating CR No.136/2026 under Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. Apparently two different Aadhar Cards of different numbers of the same person, having two addresses, have been found during the said investigation. Apart from the same one of the said Aadhar card has been used while transferring the said Audi car on the address of the said accused in Mumbai. The First Information Report further discloses that the present applicant in furtherance of his common intention with other accused has prepared the bogus Aadhar Card and the said Aadhar Card was used while transferring the vehicle. On the face of the same, the offence is serious. The investigation is in progress. The First Information Report discloses that, the applicant has played vital role in the commission of the offence. The investigation is at primary level. In such circumstances, if application is considered at this stage, there is every possibility of tampering prosecution evidence and absconding of the accused. Therefore, at this stage, I am not inclined to consider this application. Hence, the order:

O R D E R

1. Anticipatory Bail Application No.954 of 2026 is hereby rejected.

2. Anticipatory Bail Application No.954 of 2026 is disposed off accordingly.
