2. Whether the Plaintiffs further prove that the Suit Schedule Properties are the ancestral and Undivided Hindu Joint Family Properties of themselves and the defendants?
3. Whether the Plaintiffs further prove that themselves and the defendants are in joint and constructive possession of the Suit Schedule Properties?
4. Whether the Plaintiffs further prove that they entitled 2/8th share each in the suit schedule properties?
5. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that Suit 'B' Schedule Property was constructed by him out of his own funds?
6. Whether the defendants No.1, 2, 4 and 9 further proves that the husband of the defendant No.5 and father of the defendant No.6 and 7 separated from the family by way partitioning the properties through Partition deed dated 05-04-1984?

7. Whether the defendant No.1 further proves that the defendant No.2 has relinquished her share in his favour through a Release Deed dated:13.08.1999?
8. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief as sought for?
9. What Order or Decree?
