PLEA OF ACCUSED

That you the above named accused, in order to discharge your part of legal debts/ liabilities, had issued a Cheque bearing No. 180696 dated : 28.05.2025 for Rs.5,00,000/- drawn on the State Bank of India, Yashoram Chamber, Rathnagiri Road Branch, Chikmagaluru, to the complainant and when the complainant presented the said Cheque for encashment through State Bank of India, Main Branch, Chikkamagaluru, the said Cheque returned dishonoured on 29/05/2025 with a Memo as "Funds Insufficient".
