

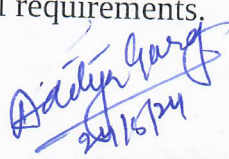

24-05-2024	The case is fixed for evidence today. The accused persons are present. The complainant has been absent from since long and there has been no attendance. The complainant has been abstaining her presence in the court and no evidence has been adduced by the complainant. As a cardinal principle of law in a complain case the onus to adduce lies on the complainant as they are responsible for conducting the prosecution. The substance of accusation was explained to the accused under section 323, 504 of IPC to which they plead not guilty and claim to be tried. All these offences are summons triable in nature. Moreover, there is no other reason on record to adjourn the proceeding of the case as ample opportunities have been provided to the complainant. Hence, the accused person Prem Shankar Pathak are accordingly acquitted from the charges and bailors are also discharged from their liabilities under their respective bail bonds, their sureties are also discharged accordingly.
