Accused Mani Ram in person represented by Sh.R.L.
Sheoran, Advocate.

Today the matter was fixed for presence of accused.
Accused appeared and moved an application for grant of bail
through his counsel.

Heard. Since the offence under which the accused has been
summoned is bailable, therefore, accused is admitted to bail on
furnishing bail bonds in sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like
amount. Requisite bonds furnished, which are accepted and attested.
Accused is released on bail in this case.

However, accused following the conditions as under:-

- (i) he shall attend in accordance with the conditions of the
bond executed by him.*
- (ii) he shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of
which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of
which he is suspected.*
- (iii) he shall not directly or indirectly make any
inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted
with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from
disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer
or tamper with the evidence.*

Necessary endorsement on the document furnished as
security by surety be made or, as the case may be, intimation in this
regard to concerned authority be sent and Reader is directed to maintain
computerized data of all particulars of the sureties as well as details of
the properties furnished as security, as is required by Hon'ble High
Court vide order dated 1.6.2018 passed in CWP No.4898 of 2018.

Now to come up on **7.2.2023** for arguments on
notice of accusation to accused.
