Plaintiff and Defendant No.1 to 3 are present. Smt. TKR, Advocate filed vakalath for D 1 to 3. Both counsels submitted that the parties have settled the matter.

The plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 3 are filed compromise petition contending that, both parties have settled the matter.

In the compromise petition, the plaintiff only have taken the shares in suit schedule properties. Upon verification they have admitted the same. The defendant No.1 to 3 have filed affidavits contended that they will not claim any share over the suit schedule properties and they have relinquished their right out love and affection by taking amount of Rs.2,00,000/-each from the plaintiff.

The contents of compromise petition is read over and explained to the plaintiff and defendants in the language known to them, the parties have admitted the same and voluntarily subscribed their respective signatures to the compromise petition.

This court is of the opinion that, the proposed settlement is voluntary and genuine. Hence, the compromise petition is accepted and the compromise entered between the parties is recorded and same was free from undue influence and coercion.

Hence, suit of the plaintiff is decreed in terms of compromise petition.

Office is directed to draw final decree in terms of compromise petition.

Office is directed to refund the court fee to the plaintiff in accordance with law.
