ORDER

1. Petitioners seek relaxation of the condition imposed by this court in Crl.M.P.No.20202/2022, dt:26.10.2022.

2. Heard both sides.

3. The petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by this court in Crl.M.P.No.18222/2022, dt:30.9.2022 for the offence u/s.406, 420 IPC with condition to appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. Subsequently, on petition, the said condition was modified to appear before the learned XVII Metropolitan Magistrate, Chennai daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders instead of respondent police.

4. Report has been received from concerned court. According to learned CPP, the petitioners have complied the condition only for 27 days. Considering the nature of offence and the number of days complied, this court is not inclined to relax the condition.

5. Hence, the petition is dismissed.
