Heard both sides.

2. The petitioners are the accused in crime No.1067/2022 of Chandera Police Station seeking permission to enter the limits of Chandera Police Station.

3. At the hearing, Mr.Nikhil Narayan, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that as per the bail order in CrI.MP No.647/23, the petitioners were restrained from entering into the limits of Chandera Police Station without previous permission from this court. He further pointed out that the petitioners are young students who had not been entering into the limits of Chandera Police Station on account of the condition imposed by the Hon'ble High Court in the bail order. He further pointed out that the petitioners have been complying the said direction till now. He therefore seeks permission of this court, permitting the petitioners to enter into the limits of Chandera Police Station taking note of the ritual in connection with their community.

4. Having considered the reason protected by the petitioners for getting an exemption from aforesaid condition, I am of the view that the charge sheet has already been submitted against the petitioners and this court has taken cognizance of the case as SC 160/2023, I am of the view that petitioners can

be granted permission to enter into the limits of Chandra Police Station. I order accordingly.

With the above observations, this petition stands disposed of.
