

**ORDER BELOW EXH. 01 IN NOTICE CASE No. 1192/N/2022**

1. This is an application filed by applicant Javed Ahmed S/o. Wahid Ahmed for getting the interim custody of seized mobile handset of POCO company and one old assembled CPU, which are seized in crime no. 686/2022 of police station Malad RPF for the offence punishable under Section 143(i) of the Railways Act.

2. The applicant submitted that he is the owner of seized articles. He is ready to abide by all the conditions which may be imposed by this court. Hence, interim custody of seized articles be given to him.

3. I.O. has objected the application on the ground that seized articles are evidence and submitted that it shall not be released. I have gone through the record. The applicant is ready to abide by all the conditions. Considering the nature of the offence, it would be proper to handover the interim custody of the seized articles to the applicant by imposing necessary conditions. Hence, the order.

**O R D E R**

1. The application is allowed.

2. Interim custody of seized mobile handset of POCO company and one old assembled CPU be handed-over to the applicant on execution of Supurtnama Bond of Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only), subject to the condition that the applicant shall produce the seized articles as and when directed by the court, till

disposal of the case.

3. I. O. is directed to prepare detail panchnama of seized articles and obtain the photograph of the seized articles before handing over the same to the applicant and filed it in the charge-sheet.

4. Inform to police station Malad RPF accordingly.
