

:ORDER ON IA NO.1:

The counsel for the plaintiff has filed IA No.1 U/o. 39 Rule 1, 2 and 3 R/W 151 of CPC requesting the Court to grant exparte temporary injunction restraining the defendant or his men agent/s anybody claiming through him from causing any damage to the suit schedule properties in any manner till disposal of the suit by dispensing the notice on I.A. No.1 by allowing this application in the interest of justice and equity.

Heard counsel for the plaintiff. Perused pleadings, affidavit in support of documents produced by the plaintiff and court records. At this stage and on available materials on record, I am satisfied that the plaintiff has made out prima-facie case in this case. Balance of convenience also lies in favour of the plaintiff. Irreparable loss and hardship will be caused

to the plaintiff if exparte temporary injunction is not granted and very purpose of filing of the suit will be frustrated.

Hence, after dispensing with prior notice to IA No.1 to the defendant I proceed to pass the following;

:ORDER :

The defendants are hereby restrained by way of exparte temporary injunction from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property of the plaintiff till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply with the mandatory provisions of Order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.

The office is hereby directed not to give the certified copy of this order to the plaintiff unless and until he complies with the mandatory provisions of Order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.

Issue suit summons, emergent notice of IA No. 1 and notice of temporary injunction to the defendant returnable by 13.10.2025.
