ORDERS ON MAIN PETITION

This is a petition filed by the petitioners under Section 13(3) of Registration of Birth and Death Act, 1969 seeking for direction by this Court to the respondent authority to enter the date of death of husband of petitioner No.1 and father of petitioner No.2 by name Jayaram S/o Rama who was died on 06.09.1999 at Halemudigere,



Mudigere Village, Kasaba Hobli, Mudigere Taluk, in the register maintained by its office.

2) The above petition was filed on 10.01.2025 and this Court has issued notice to the respondent. In-spite of service of notice, the respondent has not turned up towards this Court and remains absent.

3) Now the following points arise for consideration of this Court:

1. Whether the petitioners have made out grounds for issuance of directions as sought in the petition?

2. What order ?

4) In support of the petitioners case, the petitioner No.1 got examined herself as PW1 and got marked documents at Ex.P1 to P6 and closed their side, since the respondent remained absent the cross examination is taken as nil.

5) Having heard the petitioners counsel, this Court perused the petition, oral and documentary evidence supplied by the petitioners. Now, the findings of this Court to the above points are as follows :

Point No.1 : **In the Affirmative.**

Point No.2 : As per final order for the following:



REASONS

6) Point No.1: In order to prove the averments of the petition, the petitioner No.1 got examined herself as PW1 by filing her Affidavit in lieu of examination-in-chief. Wherein she has reiterated the petition averments. Therefore, it is needless to say as it is nothing but repetition of facts. She has also adduced the documentary evidence and got marked the same as Ex.P1 to P6 documents.

7) It has been contended by the petitioners that the deceased by name Jayaram S/o Rama who is the husband of petitioner No.1 and father of petitioner No.2 was died on 06.09.1999 at Halemudigere, Mudigere Village, Kasaba Hobli, Mudigere Taluk. But, due to oversight, mistake and inadvertence, his date of death is not registered in the concerned register of the respondent authority and now the death certificate of the deceased is required for the purpose of change of katha.

8) It is further contended by the petitioners that they have not got register the date of death of the deceased at the respondent authority and the same is not an intentional one. Further, when they approached the respondent authority, they have issued a non-availability certificate instead of issuing death certificate by stating that the date of death of the deceased is not registered. The said non-availability certificate issued by respondent is marked at Ex.P1. PW1 also adduced evidence and got marked documents at Ex.P2 to 6, which are the notarized copy



of genealogy certificate, paper publications, and notarized copies of Aadhaar cards of petitioners. Ex.P2 goes to show that the petitioners are the legal representatives of the deceased.

9) Further, the petitioners got published public notice through news papers publication in Malenadu Nakshatra and Jilla Suddi Maadhyama daily Kannada newspapers on 07.03.2025 as per Ex.P3 & P4. After newspaper publications, no objection has been received with respect to the said paper publications. Ex.P2 the genealogy affidavit, Ex.P5 & 6 are notarized copies of Aadhaar cards of petitioners are clearly goes to show that the petitioners are the legal representatives of the deceased and both of them are arrayed as parties to this petition.

10) It is germane to note that, in the present case the respondent has remained absent. Hence, the case of the petitioners are unchallenged by the respondent. Further, the petitioners have established that they are the legal representatives of the deceased, and nothing is placed by the respondent as to disbelieve the version of the petitioners. Therefore, in the event of allowing the petition, no other persons will be put into loss or injustice. On the other hand, in the event of the rejecting the petition, the petitioners will be put into the great hardship and injury. At these circumstances of the case, the petition is deserves to be allowed. Accordingly, this Court answers point No.1 **in the Affirmative.**



11) Point No.2: In view of the above findings on point No.1, this court proceed to pass the following.

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioners U/sec 13(3) of the Registration of Birth and Death Act, 1969 is hereby allowed.

The respondent is hereby directed to enter the date of death of the deceased by name Jayaram S/o Rama as died on 06.09.1999 at Halemudigere, Mudigere Village, Kasaba Hobli, Mudigere Taluk, in concerned death register and to issue death certificate in favour of the petitioners after deposit of requisite fee, if any.

The said entry shall not be a conclusive proof of death and if in case of any dispute there exist, the death entry shall be subject to proof.
