

**ORDER ON IA NO.I FLED BY THE PLAINTIFF
UNDER ORDER VII RULE 14(3) R/w Section
151 OF CPC.**

The present application has been filed by the plaintiff seeking permission to produce the documents in the above case.

2. The plaintiff contends that at the time of filing of the suit the due to inadvertence and unavoidable circumstances the plaintiff could not able to produce the documents.
