Report under the signatures of DCP North is received. It is reported that the court had directed the investigation officer to conduct further investigation on various point and file supplementary chargesheet. It is further reported that the compliance of the objections could not be completed within the stipulated period as the IO was engaged in law and order as well as security arrangement duties in connection with a protest.

The case record reveals that SHO PS Subzi Mandi Inspector Ram Manohar was summoned to assist the court for further proceedings of the matter and he appeared on 23.04.2026 and after going through the file he filed an application for further investigation. The application was not opposed by the complainant company as such matter was allowed to be investigated further as per application. The report of the DCP about directions of the court is found contrary to the report as the court has allowed the application filed by the investigating agency.

It was observed by the court after perusing the case

diary produced before it on 07.07.2026 that further investigations are neither being supervised by the ACP nor are monitored by the DCP concern. The court expected that DCP will got conducted the further investigation under his monitoring.

Since the day of allowing the application moved by the investigating agency no witness has been examined in the present matter. As per case diary, notice u/s 94 Cr.PC was served upon witnesses on 28.07.2026 and the date was given to comply the notice as 29.07.2026. No case diary qua the investigation carried out on 29.07.2026 placed before the court.

Matter is adjourned awaiting the report of further investigations for **23.09.2026** with a legitimate expectation that the further investigations will be carried out complying with the instructions issued by office of Ld. Commissioner of Police, Delhi vide Standing Order 444/2016.
