

ORDERS ON IA NO.II

The present application is filed by learned AGP on behalf of defendants No.7, 8 and 10 under Order IX Rule 7 of CPC seeking setting aside of the ex-parte order passed against defendants No.7, 8 and 10.

2. In support of said application defendants No.7, 8 and 10 filed memo of fact by stating that since they are working as government servants they could not able to appear before this Court in order to proceed further and prays to allow the application.

3. On the other hand, learned counsel for plaintiff submits no objection to the said application.

4. Having heard the arguments addressed by both the parties.

5. The present application has been filed by the defendants No.7, 8 and 10 when the matter has been posted for written statement of defendant No.9. Even though the reason stated by the defendant No.7, 8 and 10 are not satisfied to this Court in the interest of justice and equity and to avoid the multiplicity of proceedings, it is necessary to provide an opportunity to the defendants No.7, 8 and 10 to proceed further in the above case, hence the following;

ORDER

IA. No.II filed by the defendant No.7, 8 and 10 under Order IX Rule 7 of Code of civil Procedure is hereby allowed.

Ex-parte order passed against defendant No.7, 8 and 10 is set-aside and accordingly the defendant No.7, 8 and 10 are permitted to contest the suit.
