

**ORDER ON IA No.X FILED BY THE PLAINTIFF
UNDER ORDER VII RULE 14(3) OF CPC**

The present application has been filed by the plaintiff seeking permission to produce the documents in the above case.

2. The plaintiff contends that the in spite of due diligence he could not able to produce the document which are mentioned in the list in time. The said documents are very much necessary in order to prove his case and also to show the real controversy between the parties. Hence the production of documents listed along with application are very much necessary in order to prove his case and prays to allow the application.

3. On the other hand defendant filed objection by contending that the documents for which plaintiff is seeking permission to produce are irrelevant and inadmissible in evidence and the plaintiff has created such document by colluding with the revenue officials, if the said application is allowed defendant will be put to great hardship, hence prays to reject the application.

4. Heard both the counsel and perused the material placed on record.

5. This suit is filed by the plaintiff against the defendant seeking for the relief of declaration and permanent injunction. The plaintiff has come up

with this application when the matter has been posted for plaintiff evidence on additional issue, seeking permission to produce the document in support of his contention. The said documents are revenue documents. On the other hand if the defendant has any objection with regard to said documents, it is always kept open for the defendant to put question with regard to said document during cross examination.

6. On considering the above said reason this Court proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The I.A.No.X filed by the plaintiff under Order VII Rule 14(3) R/w Section 151 of C.P.C is hereby allowed.

The additional documents produced by the plaintiff is taken on record.
