ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 1 IN

1. The plaintiff and advocate absent, though called repeatedly. Vide order dated 04/03/2022 and 16/11/2022 below Exhibit 1, the hearing was directed to be heard ex-parte against defendant No.1 and 2 to 4 respectively.
2. Thereafter, on 06/02/2023 the plaintiff has filed affidavit of examination-in-chief at Exhibit 14. Since then, the matter is pending for cross-examination of the plaintiff.
3. The matter is adjourned for leading the evidence of the plaintiff since long and despite sufficient opportunities given, the plaintiff failed to lead his evidence or to take appropriate steps. Therefore, vide order dated 24/04/2024 the matter is fixed for dismissal order. However, the plaintiff failed to lead his evidence, though the matter is kept for dismissal order. In view of continuous absence of the plaintiff and no application being filed for extension of time, no reason to adjourn further. The presence of the plaintiff

is essential for the evidence to proceed further with the matter. The aforesaid conduct of the plaintiff shows that, the plaintiff is not interested to proceed with the matter and has lost interest. Therefore, the suit stands dismissed in default for want of prosecution and accordingly disposed of.
