1. Perused record. It reveals that the present petition is filed by the applicants for divorce by mutual consent under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. Accordingly, it appears that on 24/04/2019, verification of both the parties were recorded and the parties were directed to appear on 05/11/2019 i.e. after completion of cooling period of six months.

2. Record further reveals that since 05/11/2019, till date the parties have not turned to the Court for adducing their respective evidence in-spite of issuing notices through Court. So also, period of one year from 05/11/2019, has already lapsed. Hence, the conduct of the parties shows that they are not interested to proceed with the matter and no purpose would be served in keeping the matter lingering. Hence, the following order :-
