

## **ORDERS ON AD-INTERIM PRAYER**

In the above suit which is filed for bare injunction with respect to the suit schedule property, the plaintiff has contended that he is the owner in possession of the suit property which was granted to his father. The plaintiff's father had sold the said property to one B.L.Manjamma and the said sale is set-aside in PTCL.No.26/2012-13. The defendants had challenged the said order before the Deputy Commissioner wherein also, the order in PTCL.No.26/2012-13 is confirmed. Now, the defendants having filed the writ petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka and also a suit in OS.No.4/2025 before this Court, they are interfering with the plaintiff's peaceful possession of the suit property. The plaintiff has also sought for exparte temporary injunction restraining the defendants.

**2.** Having heard the learned counsel for plaintiff on ad-interim prayer, this Court has gone through and carefully perused the materials supplied by the plaintiff.

**3.** On careful perusal of the documents supplied by the plaintiff in co-joint reading with the averments of plaint, IA and its affidavit, it could be seen that the revenue entries pertaining to the suit property is in the name of Heddaiah S/o Byraiah whom the plaintiff claims to be his father. In PTCL.No.26/2012-13, the

sale of suit property by the plaintiff's father in favour of the defendant's mother, is set-aside which is also confirmed by the Deputy Commissioner. As the plaintiff himself stated, the defendants have filed writ petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka and also suit in OS.No.4/2025 before this Court. Under the circumstances, this Court is of view to hear the other side before granting any interim order. Hence, the following:

**ORDER**

Issue suit summons and emergent notice on I.A. No.I to the defendant. R/by:08.04.2025.
