

**ORDER ON IA NO.XVII FLED BY THE
PLAINTIFF UNDER ORDER VII RULE 14(3) OF
CPC.**

The present application has been filed by the plaintiff seeking permission to produce the documents in the above case.

2. The plaintiff contends that the marking of the certificate under the 63 of BSA is necessary in order to prove his case and delay caused in filing the said certificate is not intentional and deliberate. Hence prays to allow the application.

3. On the other hand learned counsel for defendants submits objection by contending that if the application is allowed then there is a chance of altering and tampering the photograph and prays to reject the application.
