

Both parties are absent. Heard both side on IA.No.3.

The plaintiffs have filed IA.No.3, seeking an order of this court to produce the documents, which are annexed in the list. In the memorandum of facts, they contended that those documents are necessary to prove their case.

Admittedly, inspite of opportunities, defendants have not filed objection to IA.No.3. Documents sought to be produced are the public documents. It is pertinent to note that mere production of documents is not conclusion of proof thereof and the admissibility of the same can be questioned at the time of marking the same. Further, the defendants will get an opportunity to cross-examine the plaintiffs on the documents, which will be marked on their behalf. Hence, it is satisfied with the reasons.

Accordingly, IA.No.3 filed by the plaintiffs under Order 7 Rule 14(3) of CPC, is hereby allowed and consequently, the documents taken on record on subject to admissibility and relevancy in evidence.
