

ORDERS ON I.A.No.4 FILED BY THE DEFENDANT
UNDER ORDER VIII RULE I(A) OF C.P.C

The present application has been filed by the defendant seeking permission to produce the additional documents in the above case by contending that during filing of the suit the defendant has not filed the above documents due to unavoidable circumstances and it is not intentional and prays to allow the application.

2. On the other hand plaintiff submits his statement of objection to the present application by contending that when the matter has been posted for the further chief of defendant, the plaintiff has come up with this application and the application is belated one and it is filed only in order to drag on the proceeding and prays to reject the application.

Heard both the parties on perusal of the materials placed on record, it appears that the reason stated by the defendant is bonafide and unintentional and in the interest of justice it is necessary to provide an opportunity for the defendant to produce the documents in order to prove his contention and if the plaintiff have any objection with respect to the above document he is having liberty to question the same during the cross examination of defendant.
